YEAR 10 EXCURSION TO GOLD COAST THEME PARKS

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Our 3 day excursion to the Gold Coast is fast approaching, so I thought I should write to you to confirm a few details and let you know what students are required to bring on the trip.

The excursion dates are from **Monday 9th of November to Wednesday 11th November**. This is three days and two nights, inclusive. The itinerary of the excursion will be;

- 9th November : **Dreamworld, and White-water World**; *Students wishing to use the water park will need to pack their swimming clothes, sunscreen and a towel in a back pack. Students need to ensure that they are wearing dry clothes when they get back on the bus.*
- 10th November : **Wet N Wild** ; *Student once again will need a towel, sunscreen and dry clothes for the bus.*
- 11th November: **Movieworld**; *Students require; sensible footwear, hat, sunscreen and appropriate clothing.*

The coaches will leave at approximately **6.00am** on Monday 9th November from Woolgoolga Skate Park. We ask you to please be there at 5.45am to allow for prompt departure. On Wednesday 11th November, we intend to depart Movieworld at approximately 3.30pm and return to Woolgoolga Skate Park at about **8.00pm**

Accommodation for 2 nights will be at Seaworld Nara Resort, where the included meals are two Breakfasts and Dinners, whilst at the Resort. All lunches while at the theme parks as well as dinner on the return trip are NOT included; these will have to be paid for by the students. Depending on individual student's appetites students should bring between \$50 and \$70 for these meals.

Students are expected to behave appropriately at all times on the excursion and adhere to normal school rules and expectations. Students are strictly prohibited from bring drugs, alcohol or cigarettes on the excursion. Any serious breaches of school rules or any unacceptable or inappropriate behaviour, will require students to be immediately collected from the Gold Coast by their parent or guardian, whether it is convenient or not. In this case further school based disciplinary action will follow.

Students are discouraged from bringing expensive electronic devices on the excursion. If students choose to bring any expensive devices they need to be aware that they are entirely responsible for the care and safety of those items. The school will not be responsible for any loss or damage to these devices.

Parents please ensure that if your student has any medication they require for the trip, that it is clearly labelled with the students name and required dosage and if necessary given to Mr Radford on the morning of the excursion.


The total cost for the excursion is \$400. Please ensure that you have paid any balance for the excursion by 2nd of November. Also please be aware that Queensland does not recognise NSW ambulance cover, so you may wish to arrange your own ambulance cover.

Below is a list of things that students will require for the excursion.

Excursion Check List

- *2 swimming out fits*
- *Beach Towel/s*
- *Hat*
- *Sunscreen*
- *Back Pack*
- *Water Bottle*
- *A few changes of appropriate clothes, including an outfit suitable for restaurant dining*
- *Thongs and shoes*
